

Curriculum Overview – Year 1 – Term 4

Computing

We will be further developing the word processing skills we learnt in term 3 by saving, opening and editing documents we have created.

History

We will be learning about famous British queens such as Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II and thinking about how life has changed over time.

In RE we will be considering how and why people celebrate sacred times such as Easter and Passover.

English

We will be using our class text (yes, it is another secret again!) to write stories, instructions and poems. We will be considering our use of language and working on adding more detail to our writing. We will be securing our use of capital letters, full stops and exclamation marks.

Design and Technology

Our DT topic will be “playgrounds.” We will be developing our cutting and joining techniques as we make prototypes of playground equipment.



Maths

Our topics in maths will include:

- Telling the time to the half hour
- Finding the difference between numbers
- Naming and discovering the properties of 3D shapes
- Simple fractions
- Measures- mass and weight

We will be continuing our studies of the plants and looking at naming plants in our local environment.
