

Curriculum Overview – Year 2- Term 1

Computing

To use logical reasoning to explain how a simple algorithm works and learn how to plan, test and debug a simple program.

History

In our 'Pirate' topic we will be looking at famous pirates and the different jobs pirates had on board a pirate ship.

R. E.

We will begin exploring by the question, 'What can we learn from sacred books?' We will look at the sacred books belonging to three world religions.

English

We will be looking at familiar and unfamiliar settings and describing these and characters. Also, we will be retelling a story from a different point of view. We will be freeze framing and hot seating to take on the role of a character, putting ourselves in their shoes.

DT

In D.T we will be designing and constructing our own treasure chests.



Maths

This term we will be starting with place value and number facts. Then looking at addition and subtraction and how these are the inverse of each other. We will then move on to money and finally measurement – focusing on length.

Science

In Science this term, we will begin looking at 'Materials'. Investigating what makes materials different and what qualities they have, deciding which materials are best suited to a particular use.

P.S.H.E.

Our topic for PSHE this term will be 'New Beginnings.' We will be discussing feelings and how we can make people feel happy and solve problems.

P. E.

In P.E. we will be developing our invasion game skills. We will be working in teams and focusing on tactics within games

Music

We will be learning how to compose sound effects to accompany a story. We will be rehearsing in groups and performing together and for Year R.
