

# Curriculum Overview – Year 2- Term 4

## Computing

We will be continuing our iSearch topic, focusing on checking multiple sources of information before answering questions.

## Geography

We will be combining our English topic with Geography this term and finding out all about life in Kenya – passports ready!

## R. E.

Continuing with the question: 'How and why do we celebrate special and scared times?' we will explore further into the beliefs and customs held in Christianity, Judaism and Islam.

## English

Our focus this term is Stories from other cultures. We will be mainly looking at stories from African authors and stories set in this varied continent. We will be reading a story written for younger children and re writing it for an older audience.

## Art

Art will focus on sculpture this term linking to other cultures. We will take our inspiration from Aboriginal artwork.



## Maths

We will begin with fractions, finding  $\frac{1}{2}$   $\frac{1}{4}$   $\frac{3}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{3}$  and counting in quarters from 0 to 10. We will then move on to multiplication and division and using our skills to solve problems. Then we will look at position and direction, linking this to Geography, followed by statistics time.

## Science

In Science we will be continuing with animals including humans. This term we will start by looking at food chains and then the importance of eating a balanced healthy diet. We will also be having some special visitors in class! During the term we will also begin looking at 'Plants' and what they need to grow.

## P.S.H.E.

Our topic for PSHE this term is 'Relationships'. We will concentrate on building and maintaining good relationships with our peers.

## P. E.

In P.E. we will be consolidating our unit on Dance and then focus on Games – learning how to work as a team.

## Music

We will be covering the topics 'Storytime' in which we will listen to famous pieces of music and 'Season' where we will continue with pitch.

## Home Learning

Your child should read their reading book every evening and a comment should be written when the book is completed. They then need to change their book the following morning and remember to take this home. Please also practise spellings and the 2, 5 and 10 times tables with your child. **Please remember that your child will need a water bottle every day.**
