

Curriculum Overview – Year 2- Term 5

Computing

We will be starting a new topic called 'iSafe'. We will be recapping the importance of internet safety with the help of some cartoon characters.

Geography

We will be completing our topic on 'What are the Seven Wonders of the World?' exploring the amazing complexity of the world around us.

We will begin looking at the question: 'How should we care for others and the world, and why does it matter?' again within the Christian, Muslim and Jewish religions.

English

In English this term we will be looking at the classic Roald Dahl story 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We will be considering who would be affected by the factory closing and writing our own newspaper articles to report a very exciting event.

Art

Art, this term, will concentrate on painting. We will be investigating and using the visual elements of line, colour and space in a painting.



Maths

This term we will start with place value learning to estimate and partition numbers in different ways. Then addition and subtraction with problem solving and money. Then finally consolidating our work on multiplication and division with problems to solve using our multiplication and division facts.

Science

In Science we will be starting the 'Living Things and their Habitats' unit of work, looking at different habitats found around the school, country and across the world. As well as finishing our 'Plants' topic.

P.S.H.E.

Our topic for PSHE this term is 'Changes'. We will concentrate on the changes we may face during our school life.

P. E.

In P.E. we will be developing our athletic skills and how to improve our own performance by learning new techniques.

Music

We will be looking at the 'Weather' unit to create word rhythms and raps and the 'Pattern' unit to create body percussions.
