

Curriculum Overview – Year 2- Term 6

Computing

We will be continuing with our unit 'iSafe' and building upon internet safety rules, particularly when using the internet for gaming at home.

Geography

We will be undertaking a local area study and using our map-making skills to navigate and map. We will also be combining Geography with D.T.

R. E.

We will be carrying on exploring the question: 'How should we care for others and the world, and why does it matter?' within the Christian, Muslim and Jewish religions.

English

We will be completing our unit on stories from other cultures with a focus on India and then focusing on non-fiction fact files to produce our own information booklets about nocturnal animals. Finally, we will be writing different style poems.

D.T

We will be combining D.T with our Geography topic looking at where our food comes from on a local scale, gaining an understanding of the importance of farming locally.



Maths

In term 6, we will start with fractions and using our knowledge to solve problems and learning to count in thirds. Then we will look at statistics, shape and position and direction all within a problem solving context. We will then look at Capacity and temperature and finally telling the time in 5 minute increments.

Science

In Science we will be completing our 'Living Things and their Habitats' unit of work. We will study how different habitats support a different species.

P.S.H.E.

Our topics this term are 'Drugs and Keeping Safe' where we will look at how to identify and store hazardous products around the home and 'SRE: Differences', focusing on what makes us male and female.

P. E.

In P.E. we will continue to develop our Athletic skills and games in preparation for Sport's Day.

Music

We will be looking at the 'Water' topic and learn to read scores and the 'Travel' unit where we will learn a travelling song using voices and instruments.
