

Curriculum Overview – Year 2- Term 2

Computing

To use logical reasoning to explain how a simple algorithm works and learn how to plan, test and debug a simple program.

History

In our topic 'The Moon' we will explore the history of the moon landing and find out about Neil Armstrong .

R. E.

We will be exploring the question, 'What can we learn from sacred books?' through retelling stories found in The Bible and The Torah.

English

This term we will be combining our English with our topic 'The Moon'. We will be designing and writing our own leaflets to advertise the moon as a tourist destination and writing letters to explain what we have found out about the moon. We will be incorporating role play into many of our lessons.

DT

In DT we will be investigating how wind-up toys work and use our findings to make our own moon buggy.



Maths

This term we will be starting with fractions, finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$. Then we will move onto multiplication and division using pictorial representations to show our working. Then looking at 2D and 3D shapes and finally we will be telling the time and solving time problems.

Science

In Science this term we will be carrying on with 'Materials' with a focus on testing and investigating what makes a material suitable for a particular use. We will also be learning why we need tests to be fair.

P.S.H.E.

Our topic for PSHE this term will be 'Getting on and falling out.' We will explore the skills needed to work in a group and how to effectively solve conflicts.

P. E.

In P.E. we will be developing our gymnastic skills and abilities using apparatus to move and travel along.

Music

We will be learning how to use vocal and body percussion and use this to perform as a class and to evaluate our performance.

Home Learning
