

# Curriculum Overview – Year 4 – Term 2

## Computing

In Computing this term we will be looking at what animation is in order to create our own short animations.

## History

This term we will be continuing to look at the Roman invasion and examine how the Roman empire changed over time.

## R. E.

In R.E. this term we will be continuing to answer the question 'What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?'

## English

This term we will be reading Iron Man by Ted Hughes.

Through this we will be looking at journalistic writing, writing in role and writing narratives. We will also explore the characters by writing in role.

## Art

Art this term we will be developing our Drawing skills. We will be using a range of media including pencils, charcoal and chalk.



## Maths

In our Maths lesson we will be learning to divide using the bus stop method, multiplying using the expanded method and exploring shapes and their properties. We will also be looking at symmetry within shapes. Towards the end of the term, we will be converting time between analogue and digital.

## Science

Science this term we will be looking at Living Things and Their Habitats. We will be discussing how environmental changes affect animals.

## P.S.H.E.

In P.S.H.E. this term we will be learning about Getting on and Falling Out.

## P. E.

In P.E. this term we will be swimming and developing our skills in invasion games such as hockey.

## French

In this unit, the children learn to express likes and dislikes and prepare and perform a radio and television advertisement. They develop confidence in manipulating numbers and learn about the Euro.
