

Curriculum Overview – Year 4 – Term 3

Computing

In our computing unit this term we will be learning how to use, send and receive emails safely and efficiently.

Geography

In Geography this term we will be answering the question 'Can you come on a great American road trip?'

R. E.

In R.E. this term we will be answering the question 'Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?'

English

This term we will be reading 'Rat Boy' by Phillip Pullman. Supported with role play and drama the children will produce at persuasive posters, instructional writing and discussion texts. The children will also explore the characters through writing in role.

D.T.

In D.T. this term we will be researching, designing and making our own money containers.



Maths

This term in Maths we will be solving problems involving money, adding and subtracting amounts with up to one decimal place.

Science

In Science this term we will be describing the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. Children will also identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

P.S.H.E.

In P.S.H.E. this term we will be learning about 'Be Good to Me.' We will be learning about how we can manage our feelings especially when we are feeling upset or anxious.

P. E.

In P.E. this term we will be creating sequences that include changing level and speed, and focus clearly on changing our body shapes.

French

In French this term, the children will learn some common adjectives, revise how to make simple feminine agreements and give instructions to one another.

Home Learning

Your child should read their AR reading book every evening and take quizzes in school to work towards their target. Homework will also be sent home and your child should complete a Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner before the end of term. **Please remember that your child will need a water bottle every day.**

Music

All the learning is focused around one song: Stop! - a rap/song about bullying. You will learn about the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and composing.
