### **Magic Show 16<sup>th</sup> July**

I'm sorry there was a mistake on yesterday's newsletter. This is for Bumble Bees and Year 1 only as Year 2 are allowed to attend their first school disco on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July instead.

### **Sports' Day**

Sports' day is on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July at 10am**. It will follow the same format as last year.

Please go to the field for 10am and sit opposite your child's house on the far side of the running track. We will be setting up between 9-10am.

At 10am the children will come to the field and sit in their houses. Please do not cross the track to speak to your child but feel free to wave!

Each house will then do activities and races and points will be earned. At the end, there will be the long distance races and the relay race with more points awarded. The last race is always the Toddler race and then the cup is presented to the winning house.

Please **send your child to school in their PE kit** on Sports' Day and they will stay in this all day. It can then stay at home until September.

Your child will need a **large water bottle, a hat** and have had **sun cream** applied to them before school. If your child needs the toilet during the morning, a member of staff will accompany them.

After the cup presentation, it is time for the Family Picnic Lunch on the field. Most parents bring this packed lunch with them and keep it in a cool box during the morning. *If your child is entitled to a free school meal and you wish your child to have a school packed lunch, you must email the office at [office@canterbury-road.kent.sch.uk](mailto:office@canterbury-road.kent.sch.uk) by Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. Any requests after this time will not be accepted.*

At lunchtime this year, to make it safer and ensure all children go with the correct adults, I will call each set of parents starting with Bumble Bees. When I call Bumble Bees, go to their 'house' to collect your Bumble Bee child and any siblings and find a space on the field to eat your lunch. I will then call Year 1 parents who can collect their Year 1 child and siblings and I will continue to do this until all the children have been collected.

If you are unable to attend, your child will be looked after by the midday meals supervisors as usual. If you can not attend and would like your child to sit with a friend you must put this in writing on the morning of Sports' Day and give it to the class teacher so that the staff know.

***Not all staff know all parents so please be patient whilst they ensure that everyone is collected safely. We must make sure that each child goes with the correct adult and there are 210 children!***

At 1pm, the bell will ring and it is time for all children to return to the playground and the great clear-up will begin!
